## **About the Positions:**

- All positions are paid a weekly salary for Lead Instructors and stipends for Co-Instructors.
- We hope for Camp to be in-person, observing all CDC and local guidelines for COVID safety, with the possibility of moving to virtual should the need arise.
- All team members of Camp Shakespeare are responsible for their own housing.
- Camp Shakespeare runs Monday-Friday with working hours being approximately 8:15am-4:45pm.
- Camp will run from mid-June through mid-July.
- All team members will be required to attend a paid Orientation, Load In, and any performance nights that involve their campers (usually 2-3 Friday nights throughout the summer).
