

Kentucky Shakespeare seeks a **Carpenter** for their 65<sup>th</sup> annual free Shakespeare Festival in Louisville's Central Park. The sets team consists of the Technical Director, Lead Carpenter, 2 carpenters, and 2 interns. The team construct one changeable set for three mainstage productions. The carpenter position is a non-union, professional, full-time contract for 11 weeks.

Kentucky Shakespeare is a not-for-profit arts organization, and the summer festival is presented non-ticketed and free of cost to audiences in this public park.

<u>Requirements</u>: Undergraduate degree or comparable experience in the field. Experience with outdoor theatre is a plus but not required. Excellent attention to craft, self-motivation, and a commitment to teamwork are essential!

<u>Contract dates</u>: April 21-July 6, 2025. The scene shop works 40 hours a week, almost always Monday-Friday 9:00-5:00.

<u>Pay</u>: W2 seasonal employment contract, email for salary range. Housing is possible, but local hires are preferred.
