



Kentucky Shakespeare seeks a **Stitcher** for their 65th annual free Shakespeare Festival in Louisville's Central Park. The stitcher will work in the costume shop with the costume designer/shop manager, draper, and one intern. The team builds, shops, or alters up to 80 costumes for three full length Shakespeare productions during the summer season. The stitcher position is a non-union, professional, full-time contract for 12 weeks. The position is adaptable for entry level stitchers or those who are more experienced.

Kentucky Shakespeare is a not-for-profit arts organization, and the summer festival is presented non-ticketed and free of cost to audiences in this public park.

Requirements: Undergraduate degree or comparable experience in the field. Experience with Renaissance styles, costume crafts, and alterations are a plus but not required. Excellent attention to detail, self-motivation, and a commitment to teamwork are essential!

Contract dates: April 14-July 6, 2025. The costume shop works 40 hours a week, almost always Monday-Friday 9:00-5:00.

Pay: W2 seasonal employment contract, email for salary range. Housing is possible, but local hires are preferred.
