

Kentucky Shakespeare seeks a **Technical Director** for their 65th annual free Shakespeare Festival in Louisville's Central Park. The TD will oversee a staff of three carpenters and two interns to construct one changeable set for three mainstage productions. Kentucky Shakespeare is a not-for-profit arts organization, and the summer festival is presented non-ticketed and free of cost to audiences in this public park. The stage and lighting truss are permanent, and the scenery is constructed each year. This non-union position reports to the Associate Artistic Director and works closely with the scenic designer and production team.

<u>Requirements</u>: Undergraduate degree or comparable experience in the field. Experience in outdoor theatre a plus but not required. Excellent leadership, patience, and focus on teamwork are essential!

<u>Contract dates</u>: April 21-July 6, 2025. Most weeks are Monday-Friday, and the three tech weeks have adjusted hours.

<u>Pay</u>: W2 seasonal employment contract, email for salary range. Housing is possible, but local hires are preferred.
