

Kentucky Shakespeare seeks a **Wardrobe Supervisor** for their 65th annual free Shakespeare Festival in Louisville's Central Park. The Wardrobe Supervisor will work backstage during the 11-week performance season, sometimes supervising an intern and sometimes as the solo costume staff person. The WS is responsible for maintaining the costumes for the three-show summer season to the specifications of the costume designer and production directors. The WS works directly with actors to achieve some wig and hair looks. The WS transports costumes to and from the outdoor performance space, though they are not always responsible for the laundry. Kentucky Shakespeare is a not-forprofit arts organization, and the summer festival is presented non-ticketed and free of cost to audiences in this public park. The Wardrobe Supervisor is a non-union position who reports to the Costume Designer/Shop Manager and Production Stage Manager.

<u>Requirements</u>: Undergraduate degree or comparable experience in the field. Experience in outdoor theatre a plus but not required. Excellent leadership, patience, and focus on teamwork are essential!

<u>Contract dates</u>: May 19-August 10, 2025. All performances are in the evening, and daytime hours are occasionally required as well.

<u>Pay</u>: W2 seasonal employment contract, email for salary range. Housing is possible, but local hires are preferred.
